Also attach a copy of your transcript (a duplicate of an official transcript or printout from myuh/banner are fine.)

If you are enrolled as a PAMI student, include this in your essay and describe how the Asia Field Study is part of your PAMI education. If you are a non-native English speaker, provide your TOEFL score and/or UHM ELI placement test date and results in item 10b and 10c. If you have any dietary or medical restrictions, list these on the reverse side of the 500-word essay page.

The completed application along with a \$200 deposit (made payable to "Research Corporation of the University of Hawaii" or "RCUH") are due on **March 19, 2011**. We will notify you of your acceptance and financial aid by April 5, 2011. The additional estimated balance due of \$4,800 (total of \$5,000) is required on April 23, 2011, along with your passport (with an expiration date no earlier than January 30, 2012).
